## Conversing With God By His Word and Our Prayers: 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 1.26ff

*"For consider your calling, brethren, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble; but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, so that no man may boast before God."*

Holy God, You have called us **not** because we were highly credentialed or had anything that You need but we have often thought, spoken and acted as if You chose us because we are better than other people.
