## **A Corporate, Responsive Confession of Sin:**

## The Scripture Reading: *Hebrews 11.5-6; Genesis 5.18-24; Jude 1.14-16*

*Hebrews 11.5-6* By faith Enoch was taken up so that he would not see death; AND HE WAS NOT FOUND BECAUSE GOD TOOK HIM UP; for he obtained the witness that before his being taken up he was pleasing to God. <sup>6</sup> And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
